at the 2024 Manitoba Air Show

Saturday, August 3 and Sunday, August 4, 2024

Southport, Manitoba (by Portage la Prairie)

The Opportunity:

- Celebrate the RCAF's 100th Anniversary
 - Honour RCAF veterans and members of the regular and reserve forces.
 - See the Snowbirds, Skyhawks Parachute Team, Pitts Special S2-B aircraft, Avro Lancaster Bomber, and planes from the Commonwealth Aviation Museum in Brandon. Find more information on the 2024 Manitoba Air Show website.
- Promote the diversity of car clubs and classic and special interest vehicles to a wide audience.
- Enjoy free entry to Air Show for the driver and one passenger (\$32 value per person).
- Purchase a commemorative t-shirt for the driver of each pre-registered vehicle in attendance for only \$10.00; MSRA is subsidizing the cost of the t-shirt.
- Opportunity to buy additional t-shirts including children's sizes at full price.

The Basics:

- Come as a car club group or individually.
- Attend one day or both; with overnight security for those wanting to leave their vehicle on-site.
- Pay nothing for car show entry.
- Sit by your vehicle.
- Note that flags, small tents, and other such display items are banned due to safety risk given the planes passing.
- Pre-register, if possible. Pre-registration AND attendance are required to receive the commemorative event t-shirt at half price.
- Enjoy the comfort of a large tent for gathering and protection from the elements. Registration items and t-shirts will be available at the tent, provided by MSRA.
- Bring your own food if you wish or purchase from food vendors; some snacks and water will be available, at no cost, in the tent.
- Be prepared because the event is "cash-free" for all sales transactions.

Venue Information:

- Adhere to Air Show rules that prohibit the following items for safety reasons:
 - Beer, wine, liquor or any other alcoholic beverage
 - Weapons, firearms, fireworks, and explosives
 - Pets, other than service animals
 - Large umbrellas and tents
 - RC aircraft, drones, kites, or any flying item
 - Laser pointers,
 - Any other items that security personnel deem a security risk.
- Note that Air Show Security will be monitoring the site for safety and security issues and dealing with them in a serious manner.
- Ensure protection of any personal property in your vehicle or unattended.

Entering the Venue:

- Arrive at the mustering point at Rotary Republic Park at 125 Cambridge Road (east of River Road) for 8:00 am.
- Note that there is no gravel on the route to Southport; however there is some gravel within Rotary Republic Park.
- Parade into the site at 8:30 am; prior to the gates opening to the public. Expected arrival is 8:30 am. Participants will be guided to the designated car show location.

Exiting the Venue:

- Leave at approximately 5:00 pm. The public will depart first, beginning around 3:30 pm.
- Enjoy the fun options being developed for the time between the end of the air show and car show departure. Ideas include: outdoor games, card and board games, and a trivia contest. Other ideas are welcome! There will be PRIZES!

Miscellaneous:

- Note that organizers assure us that issues raised about previous air shows have been addressed.
- Advise us if trailer parking is required. It is available, with a parking pass, on a nearby public lot but not in the car show space. There will also be free parking near the mustering point.
