## **RODARAMA - 2026 CAR SHOW**

### RULES AND REGULATIONS

### **Section 1 EXHIBITOR HOURS**

The Exhibitor entrance will be open one hour prior to the show opening for cleaning and rearranging of displays, etc. security will be provided by surveillance cameras and a roving security personnel.

### MOVE-IN

Thursday, April 23, 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. Friday, April 24, 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Vehicles must be in Exhibition Park Building by 2:00 p.m. Friday and all set up MUST be complete by 4 p.m., as there cannot be any set up or move in while the show is open.

### **SHOW TIMES**

Friday April 24, 5 PM - 9 PM Saturday April 25, 10 AM - 9 PM Sunday April 26, 10 AM - 5 PM

### MOVE-OUT

Sunday, April 26, 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. All removal must be completed on time, or you may be responsible for towing, removal, and storage or clean up charges – unless otherwise agreed with MSRA show's management. No move out of vehicles or tearing down of displays will be permitted before approval has been given by the MSRA show management.

## **Section 2 ADMISSION WRISTBANDS**

With each confirmed and accepted Application, upon move-in, two wristbands will be issued. The wristbands must be worn and shown at the door to gain admission to the show.

# Wrist band issued for show entry must be worn for the duration of the car show and will be issued ONLY to Exhibitors with vehicles in the show.

Section 3 AWARDS - Awards will be presented on Sunday at 4:00 PM

**AWARD CLASSES** - Please see the Schedule A for award classes. Please note that the classes may be modified as required.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Locked vehicles will NOT be judged. Vehicles to be judged must have hood, doors and trunk open from setup to tear down. Judges will not open vehicles.

## **Section 4 SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. No alarms of any kind are to be set while the vehicle is in the building.
- For promotional purposes, the MSRA show management has theright to use any submitted photographs of the displayed vehicles.
- 3. No commercial advertising, or distribution of handouts, business cards or flyers, etc. will be permitted with any non-commercial display, un-less permission is granted in writing by the MSRA show management. A vehicle specification display sign, no larger than approximately 20"W x 36"H, is permitted.
- 4. Neither the MSRA show management, the sponsors and their staff, nor any officer or staff member, director or shareholder connected to the show, as well as the owners, staff and managers of the building where the show is produced shall be responsible or liable for any loss or damage to any part of the Exhibitors display or vehicle.
- 5. Once the Exhibitor has placed the vehicle and its display, they shall not be able to remove or conceal the vehicle until the declaration by the MSRA show management that move-out has officially begun.
- 6. All displays must be free standing and composed of fireproof materials. All batteries must be disconnected and gas caps either locked or taped. <u>Drip protection MUST be used under vehicle engine</u>, transmission and rear end.
- 7. The Exhibitor of the displayed vehicle must have his/her own insurance on the vehicle, the display and accessories. The insurance must include public liability and any required permits fordriving in and out of the show building.
- 8. No alcoholic beverages permitted on the vehicle display area
- 9. Chairs will not be permitted in the vehicle display area.

- 10. The MSRA show management has the right to have an Exhibitor and its representatives, or a member of his/her party removed from the show and building for misconduct or mischievous behavior.
- 11. If possible, Exhibitor could provide their own stanchions and rope
- 12. Careless or reckless driving, over 3mph or 5kph, will not be tolerated. This includes during setup and teardown.
- 13. Electrical connections will not be available for your display.
- 14. Although Manitoba government regulation no longer require mandatory masks and vaccination, MSRA strongly suggest you wear a mask for protection of Yourself, volunteers, and the public.

### Section 5 HOW TO ENTER YOUR VEHICLE INTO THE SHOW

- Please complete the Application form and send it along with a good quality photograph which will be returned to you. Please have your \$40.00 (\$30 <u>before</u> April 1, 2026) per vehicle entry fee accompany the entry application.
- 2. One application form for each vehicle please.

### **Section 6 PAYMENT**

- Exhibitors are required to submit their Application with the entry fee no later than March 1, 2026 to be considered by the MSRA show management.
- 2. Cancellations with full refund must be requested in writing and submitted to MSRA no later than April 14, 2026.
- 3. Cancellations after April 14, 2026 will not result in a refund of any payments already submitted to MSRA.

# MSRA show management reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry in its sole discretion. You will be notified of Your Application status.

# Section 7 CONFIDENTIALITY and PERSONAL INFORMATION PROTECTION

- 1. "Confidential Information" means any information regarding a Party, disclosed by either Party ("Disclosing Party") or otherwise made available to the other Party ("Receiving Party") pursuant to this Application, whether intentionally or inadvertently, including without limitation information related to Disclosing Party's intellectual property, marketing plans, members, general business operations, finances, suppliers, or documents which are expressly designated as confidential; provided, however that Confidential Information will not include information that: (a) is now generally available or becomes generally available to the public without breach of this Application; (b) is lawfully obtained from a third party or parties without a duty of confidentiality; (c) is known to Receiving Party prior to disclosure without fault or breach of confidentiality obligation; or (d) is at any time developed by Receiving Party independently of any disclosure from Disclosing Party.
- "Personal Information" has the same meaning as the Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act (Canada), S.C. 2000, c. 5, or other similar legislation.
- 3. Except as expressly permitted in this Section, the Receiving Party will keep confidential and will not disclose or use the Disclosing Party's Confidential Information for itself or the benefit of any third party without the prior written consent of the Disclosing Party. The Receiving Party will use the same level of security precautions to protect the Disclosing Party's Confidential Information that the Disclosing Party uses to protect its own Confidential Information of like kind.
- 4. MSRA acknowledges and agrees that, in the performance of its obligations under this Application, MSRA may have access to Personal Information of Exhibitor. MSRA will comply with all applicable law respecting Personal Information. MSRA will collect, use and disclose Personal Information solely for the purposes set out herein and for no other purpose.
- 5. Exhibitor acknowledges and approves the use of their Personal Information for the purposes of: (a) organizing and presenting the RODARAMA car show referenced herein, (b) displaying class winner namesand vehicle details on the MSRA website (<a href="https://msra.ca/">https://msra.ca/</a>), if applicable

- 1. Street rod 1900-1934
- 2. Street rod 1935-1948
- 3. Classic restored 25 years & older
- 4. Classic unrestored 25 years & older (**NO** visible changes or modifications)
- 5. Muscle car 1964-1973 factory stock (**NO** visible changes or modifications)
- 6. Muscle car 1964-1973 non stock (Must be modified)
- 7. Custom cruiser 1949-1960 (Must be modified)
- 8. Street machine 1961-1992 (Must be modified)
- 9. Trucks/Vans 25 years & older factory stock (**NO** visible changes or modifications)
- 10. Modified Trucks/Vans 25 years & older (Must be modified)
- 11. Off road competition (Race or Competition type vehicle)
- 12. Special interest (example: kit car or hand crafted vehicle)
- 13. Work in progress (evidence of major work in progress must be visible)
- 14. Exhibition Only (Exhibitor to declare before show opening **NO** judging)

**NOTE**: class 4, 5, and 9 will be allowed changes to paint and bright work only, class 11 safety equipment is emphasized.
